Overview

Who is this course for?

This course is aimed at professionals who wish to develop the knowledge and skills to specialise in the teaching of English to speakers of other languages either in a classroom or online context.

This course will develop your knowledge of:

- Preparing lesson plans and schemes of work
- Resources and materials
- Adapting resources and lessons to meet the needs of younger learners



Entry requirements

- You will need to have achieved at least a Level 2 or hold GCSEs (A-C or 4-9) in English and Maths
- You will need a proficient level of spoken and written English. Ideally, B2+ or C1 on the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference) or IELTS Level 5
- You will also be required to demonstrate your ability to teach English through a range of observed lessons. Ideally, you will have access to a group of learners to demonstrate this

Key information

- The course is made up of 11 units
- 180 guided learning hours (guided learning hours are the awarding bodies estimate of how long a learner will need to spend studying to complete their qualification)
- 32 credits at Level 5 (credits can be used for "credit transfer" towards other qualifications. They can be added together and built up over time)
- 3 teaching practice sessions must be completed in order for you to achieve this qualification. One of 25 minutes and two of 45 minutes to 1 hour
- This is a distance-learning course that can be studied in your own time
- Assignments will be accessed via the online learning portal when they are to be completed and returned to the course tutor for assessment
- You will receive timely feedback to improve your work should you need to
- Personal tutoring and coaching from a qualified teacher (the importance of this cannot be underestimated)
- After the successful completion of the course, you will receive your nationally recognised digital certificate
- A paper certificate can be issued on request at an additional administration fee of £40 (please allow 15 working days for issue)
- Learners need to complete this certificate within 24 months of registration

*(TQT) is the total amount of time, in hours, expected to be spent by a student to achieve a qualification. It includes both guided learning hours (which are listed separately) and hours spent in preparation, study and assessment.

Career path

Once qualified you will be able to teach English as a foreign language and for those with degrees it could lead to undertaking a teaching qualification and achieving QTS. Through our sister company we can help you find your first TEFL post abroad.
